



Announcement of Thaiyawas Subdistrict Administrative Organization
Subject: Policy of not accepting neither gifts nor profits from performing duties
(No Gift Policy) Fiscal year 2026

I, Mr. Suthinai Changwatsuk, Mayor of Thaiyawas Subdistrict Administrative Organization, in my capacity as the highest-ranking executive, hereby declare that. The Thaiyawas Subdistrict Administrative Organization will be an organization where all executives and government officials will not accept any gifts or presents of any kind, while/before/after performing their duties, as this may lead to corruption and misconduct. This policy shall apply to all executives, officials, employees, and personnel of Thaiyawas Subdistrict Administrative Organization. It reflects the Organization's commitment to conducting public administration with integrity, transparency, accountability, and strict adherence to ethical standards. All personnel are required to uphold morality, maintain discipline, perform their duties with honesty and fairness, and place public interest above personal interest. They shall also provide public services with courtesy, humility, and responsibility, thereby serving as good role models in society. In order to ensure effective and concrete implementation, all personnel of Thaiyawas Subdistrict Administrative Organization are required to strictly comply with the following measures:

I, Mr. Suttinai Jangwatsuk, Chief Executive of the Thaiyawat Subdistrict Administrative Organization, as the highest-ranking executive, hereby declare that our organization adopts a "No Gift Policy." All executives and public officials shall not accept any gifts or rewards before, during, or after performing their duties to prevent any form of corruption and misconduct.

Furthermore, I am committed to leading our personnel to firmly adhere to the country's core pillars: **the Nation, Religion, the Monarchy**, and the democratic regime with the King as Head of State.

To achieve this, all personnel at all levels of the Thaiyawat Subdistrict Administrative Organization shall uphold morals, ethics, and good citizenship by adhering to the following guidelines:

1. The giving or receiving of bribes, gifts, gratuities, or any other benefits in connection with official duties is strictly prohibited.
2. No official shall allow his or her family members or close associates to give or receive bribes, gifts, gratuities, or any other benefits on his or her behalf in connection with official duties.
3. All personnel shall perform their duties solely for the benefit of the public and shall refrain from any act that may give rise to a conflict of interest or result in personal gain at the expense of public interest.
4. The acceptance or giving of gifts or other benefits shall be strictly controlled and shall be in full compliance with the rules, regulations, and criteria prescribed by the Office of the National Anti-Corruption Commission and other relevant laws.

5. All personnel shall uphold a zero-tolerance policy toward corruption and misconduct in all forms, including the giving or receiving of bribes, gifts, gratuities, or any other benefits related to official duties.

It is hereby announced and applied to all.
